Prosecco

This sparkling wine made from grapes of the Glera variety grown in the Province of Treviso, has a brilliant straw yellow colour, with greenish highlights; its nose is fruity and rather intense, and it is fresh and well-balanced on the palate.



Chianti Classico

This Chianti Classico is produced from specially selected Sangiovese grapes grown in the vineyards of Chianti Classico appellation, the most ancient Chianti area. It is deep ruby red in color. Intense and characteristic bouquet, earthy, with wild red berries and under-wood notes. Harmonious, dry, savory, strong and persistent.



“PassiMento” Red Blend

Passione e Sentimento (Passion and Feeling), celebrates the city of love par excellence, Verona, not in this case only because of its history and monuments, but also because of its wine. Deep ruby red in color. The nose has intense aromas of red berries with hints of spices. The palate is balanced with velvety tannins, and it has a soft and round finish.



Moscato d'Asti

Situated in the hills around Santo Stefano Belbo, in the heart of the production zone with soils characteristically known as "white soils" ideal for the moscato vine. Straw yellow in color, with fragrant aromas and a delicate sweetness characteristic of the moscato grape.
