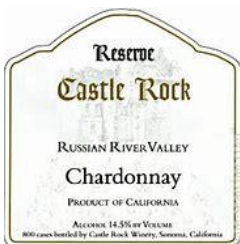


# MARCH WINE CLUB



## Castle Rock Reserve Russian River Valley Chardonnay

This concentrated wine has nice depth and integration, and has flavors of pear, butter, and spice. This Chardonnay is made from grapes grown in the Russian River Valley, one of California's most prestigious growing appellations. Here, the fog-cooled climate and well-drained soils provide ideal growing conditions for grapes which produce some of the finest wines in the world.



## Silver Peak Pinot Noir - Sonoma County

Our Sonoma County Pinot Noir displays earthy, fresh cherry and red raspberry aromas accented by notes of sandalwood and mineral. Medium-bodied and supple on the palate, with fine tannins, the wine delivers juicy black cherry, red currant and black raspberry flavors that persist throughout a long, lively finish.



## Edge Cabernet Sauvignon - Alexander Valley

The complex nose offers notes of black currant, cassis and brambleberry. Hints of baking spice and graphite combine with the layers of fruit to form an extremely balanced wine while the finish displays a bright acidity and rich yet focused tannins.



## Black Oak Merlot - Healdsburg

Black Oak Merlot is garnet red in color, deep and rich-looking. The wine is warm and layered with cocoa and ripe blueberry aromas. The fresh plum flavors are indicative of a homemade, dense-like strawberry jam, with hints of black cherry and red licorice. With a fine tannin structure, this medium-bodied wine is consistently smooth, all the way through to the finish.
