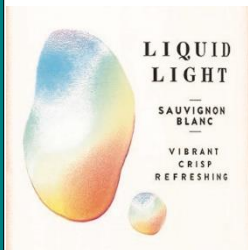

Liquid Light Sauvignon Blanc

Just as a drop of water refracts light into a unique, vibrant spectrum of colors and textures, Liquid Light projects a dazzling range of flavors on the palate – citrus, tropical and orchard fruits with a flash of acidity typical of Washington State’s cool climate.



Textbook Chardonnay

Shows bright, textured fruit, very subtle new French oak and a creamy texture; all in balance with fragrant and floral pear, melon and mineral notes. We think it is a “textbook” example of this noble variety grown in these outstanding Napa Valley sites.



Scarlet Vine Cabernet Sauvignon

100% Cabernet grapes from Chile’s Maipo Valley; Dark cherry red. Aromas of red and black forest fruit, spicy, scented, ripe touches. Sweet, compact, fruity, toasted, long mouth.



SONoROSSO Sweet Red

A delicious expression of Northern Italy where grapes are enriched with color, aroma, and a soft body thanks to the Italian sun. Sonoroso showcases flavors of red fruits, sweet spice, and delicate scents of plum and violet. Notes of blackberry & cherry give a sensuous taste, finishing with a touch of sweetness.
