WHITES

- SAUVIGNON BLANC – Rodney Strong**
 Sonoma, California, 2014 32
 Citrus notes of grapefruit and lime blossoms, with a slightly herbaceous quality, on the nose. Ripe honeydew melon and tropical characteristics finish on the palate.
- VERDEO – Miguel Torres**
 Rueda, Spain 20
 Intense and fragrant, it offers clean floral notes against an enticing ripe fruit backdrop. The palate is silky and smooth, displaying the fresh herbaceous expression
- ROSÉ – Ferrari-Carano 100% Dry Sangiovese**
 Sonoma, California, 2016 24
 With aromas and flavors of fresh-picked wild strawberries, raspberries, watermelon, cherries and cranberries, this refreshing and lively wine offers finesse balanced by mouthwatering acidity and an elegant finish.
- RIESLING – Eroica**
 Columbia Valley, Washington, 2014 38
 Sweet lime and mandarin orange aromas with subtle mineral note. The mouth-watering acidity is beautifully balanced by flavorful Washington Riesling fruit.
- CHENIN BLANC – Ernie Els “Big Easy”**
 Western Cape, South Africa, 2014 29
 It opens with honey-suckle, cantaloupe and kumquat notes. This upbeat and complex nose leads to a more mineral and serious palate, that exudes elegance and poise.
- ROSÉ – Bailli de Provence**
 Provence, France, 2014 28
 Ripe spice and pepper, fresh red fruits and a keenly refreshing aftertaste.
- VERDEJO – Vicaral**
 Rueda, Spain, 2015 25
 The nose gives tropical fruit and green apple. On the palate, tastes of anise, citrus and tropical fruits.

WHITE BLEND – Torres “Viña Sol”

Catalonia, Spain, 2015 20
 The wine offers fresh floral aromas with strong fruit undertones of apple, orange and banana, and an intriguing exotic note of lychee. Light and silky on the palate with delicate acidity and wonderful length.

REDS

- TEMPRANILLO (CRIANZA) – Torres, “Celeste”**
 Ribero del Duero, Spain, 2012 42
 Intense dark fruit aromas like wild blackberries, blueberry, and dried plums, with smoky and roasted coffee notes against a wonderfully elegant oaky backdrop.
- MERLOT – Drumheller**
 Columbia Valley, Washington, 2014 26
 Aromas of blueberry subtle spice and rose petals with hints of cocoa. Balanced, this wine is structured yet lively.
- RED BLEND – Casa Santos Lima, Colossal**
 Reserva, Lisboa, Portugal, 2013 30
 Extremely rich aroma of red ripe fruits and some floral notes. In the mouth, it shows great complexity with notes of plums and blackberries. The finish is rich and elegant.
- PETITE VERDOT – Callejon Del Crimen**
 Mendoza, Argentina, 2008 48
 Rich black fruits, with hints of tobacco and dried fruits.
- TEMPRANILLO (CRIANZA) – Altos Íbericos**
 Rioja, Spain, 2013 32
 Floral and fruit aromas with spicy and smoky notes imparted by oak aging. Velvety smooth, with juicy tannins.
- CABERNET SAUVIGNON – Seven Falls**
 Wahluke Slope, Washington, 2014 36
 Opens with darker notes of coffee and cocoa, then transcends into black fruits including cherry and plum, with hints of mint, herb and spice.
- SYRAH – Porcupine Ridge**
 Swartland, South Africa, 2014 20
 The juicy palate shows blackberry fruit, vibrant licorice and hints of cloves. The spicy finish lingers with a bouquet of violets and black cherry following through from the palate.
- PINOTAGE – Robertson Winery**
 Robertson, South Africa, 2013 23
 Delicious flavors of ripe strawberry, banana, juicy plums and rich, red cherry
