WHITES

VERDEJO – Vicaral

Rueda, Spain, 2015 25

The nose gives tropical fruit and green apple. On the palate, tastes of anise, citrus and tropical fruits.

RIESLING – Eroica

Columbia Valley, Washington, 2014 38

Sweet lime and mandarin orange aromas with subtle mineral note. The mouth-watering acidity is beautifully balanced by flavorful Washington Riesling fruit.

SAUVIGNON BLANC – Rodney Strong

Sonoma, California, 2014 32

Citrus notes of grapefruit and lime blossoms, with a slightly herbaceous quality, on the nose. Ripe honeydew melon and tropical characteristics finish on the palate.

CHARDONNAY – Evans & Tate "Butterball"

Margaret River, Australia, 2014 28

Intensely flavored fruit was exposed to Premium French oak, during fermentation, creating a buttery smooth combination of ripe peach, melon and cashew.

ROSÉ – Bailli de Provence

Provence, France, 2014 28

Ripe spice and pepper, fresh red fruits and a keenly refreshing aftertaste.

VERDEO – Miguel Torres

Rueda, Spain 20

Intense and fragrant, it offers clean floral notes against an enticing ripe fruit backdrop. The palate is silky and smooth, displaying the fresh herbaceous expression

WHITE BLEND – Torres "Viña Sol"

Catalonia, Spain, 2015 20

The wine offers fresh floral aromas with strong fruit undertones of apple, orange and banana, and an intriguing exotic note of lychee. Light and silky on the palate with delicate acidity and wonderful length.

REDS

GARNACHA – Miguel Torres, "Sangre de Toro"

Catalonia, Spain, 2013 25

Fresh, expressive and intense red fruit aromas with a subtle nuance of oak aging. Velvety on the palate.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON - Tonel 46 Reserve

Mendoza, Argentina, 2013 38

Purple-red tones, with aromas of ripe red peppers, and red fruit, complex with hints of chocolate and tobacco.

TEMPRANILLO (CRIANZA) – Torres, "Celeste"

Ribera del Duero, Spain, 2012 42

Intense dark fruit aromas like wild blackberries, blueberry, and dried plums, with smoky and roasted coffee notes against a wonderfully elegant oak backdrop.

MERLOT – Drumheller

Columbia Valley, Washington, 2014 26

Aromas of blueberry subtle spice and rose petals with hints of cocoa. Balanced, this wine is structured yet lively.

RED BLEND – Casa Santos Lima, Colossal

Reserva, Lisboa, Portugal, 2013 30

Extremely rich aroma of red ripe fruits and some floral notes. In the mouth, it shows great complexity with notes of plums and blackberries. The finish is rich and elegant.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON – Rodney Strong

Sonoma, California, 2013 44

Lush, dark berries and ripe plums dominate the glass, while hints of cassis and cocoa play in the background.

PETITE VERDOT – Callejon Del Crimen

Mendoza, Argentina, 2008 48

Rich black fruits, with hints of tobacco and dried fruits.

TEMPRANILLO (CRIANZA) – Altos Íbericos

Rioja, Spain, 2013 32

Floral and fruit aromas with spicy and smoky notes imparted by oak aging. Velvety smooth, with juicy tannins.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON – Seven Falls

Wahluk Slope, Washington, 2014 36

Opens with darker notes of coffee and cocoa, then transcends into black fruits including cherry and plum, with hints of mint, herb and spice.
