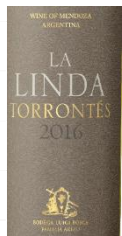

Salton "Flowers" White Blend – Bento Gonçalves, Brazil

It has a faint, bright yellow color. It also expresses a remarkable aromatic intensity, which emphasizes the qualities of the varieties that make up the cut. There are aromas of citrus fruits, white flowers, honey, peach and banana. Its flavor is slightly sweet, with a well-balanced acidity.



Finca La Linda Torrontés – Mendoza, Argentina

La Linda Torrontés is a clear yellow white with an expressive nose of floral and tropical fruit aromas, with some grapefruit notes. Entrance in the mouth is sweet and flowery, with white peach flavors and a touch of orange peel jam. Delightfully fresh, fruity and very smooth.



Red Schooner "Voyage 4" Malbec – Mendoza, Argentina

This Malbec is made from grapes grown in the Andes Mountains, shipped chilled to Napa Valley and produced with the same techniques as our Caymus Cabernet. Falling outside standard labeling rules, it does not include a vintage date but is known by the voyage from which it was produced (Voyage 3 is the 2012 vintage). Offering scents of ripe plums and cherries, this wine is powerful and supple, with flavors of French oak and soft tannins.



Alcançe Gran Reserva Carmenère – Maule Valley, Chile

Carmenère, the obscure Bordeaux variety once believed extinct, has become Chile's signature grape. Lush notes of black fruits, blueberries, and spice are abundant in the nose and follow through the fruity, spicy palate. Elegant tannins provide structure and elegance. This is a powerful wine with a beautiful personality whose rich flavors truly capture the essence of the San Francisco Vineyard.
